# Keep coming back!

"I never thought I would get it.

I come from a dysfunctional childhood. My father was an alcoholic and molested me when I was very young. My mother was a rageful compulsive overeater. Rage-Full. She was a violent "disciplinarian" and constantly criticizing me. But the worst thing was, was that I was happy. And she hated me for it. I wouldn't eat as a kid, but then severe depression hit at 11 and my compulsive overeating began. Then in high school, the run around of dieting, over-exercising, weight yo-yoing. Food had become my secret best friend.

At 19 I had another traumatic event, and my bulimia took off. I was suddenly completely isolated. *I lost my personality*. I went to work, bought the binge food and purged. This was my entire existence. I also took laxatives. You're supposed to take 1 or 2, but I took 10 or 12. The heart palpitations in the middle of the night were terrifying. The diarrhea was insane. There's much more... This went on and on until at 29 I was suicidal. I went into treatment and was abstinent for 3 months. Unbelievable!

But I couldn't maintain it - and went back to binging and purging. Why? I can see now how truly scared of people I was. I was afraid of rejection; afraid of "bothering" someone; and really terrified of trusting anyone. I couldn't last with a sponsor because I was afraid to be truly honest and get that vulnerable. I know now that it was severe shame. But all I knew back then was fear. Fear, misery, and *just wanting to hide*.

What was the turning point?

1.) I finally told my mother and sisters that my father was the perpetrator, and ten tons of shame were lifted from me.

2.) I was finally so desperate from decades of binging and self-loathing, that I finally did the unthinkable – I sought a Higher Power. I used to hate the word "God" when I got here. I thought it was dopey, for religious fanatics. But the gift of desperation drove me to *Seek a Higher Power*. And it's the best move I've made in my recovery. This is when my healing began. My Higher Power gave me the strength to reach out to others. And my H.P. helped me realize that I deserve recovery and a good life too. Self-acceptance and even self-love began. That was quite a while ago and I now have 16 years of abstinence. And I still have-to pinch myself sometimes, believe me!

But the thing I want to emphasize is that back then, I thought I would never make it. I failed for so many years, I thought I would *never get this program*. And here I am with years of solid abstinence. You can do it too.

You will find people you can relate to.

Stick around and push yourself to reach out.

I'd never be where I am today, if I didn't.
